10. Guest Speaker - Paul Haynes

- a. Kingsmount Sidewalk Stamps: A walk back in time.
  - i. They are unique to our neighborhood, though not too certain why. But they are common at the turn of the 20th century. He knows of 8 in the area.
  - ii. Wants to bring awareness to the sidewalk stamp and a will/way to preserve them.
  - iii. Paul regularly leads hikes through CGS.
  - iv. Gave a brief history of the Kingsmount-Bell Park area.
  - v. The first sidewalk was poured in suburbs c.1910 (marion/worthington/ south of the CPR tracks)
  - vi. They are located:
    - 1. SE corner of Worthington and Riverside (Worthington Crescent 1931 (?)
    - 2. Marion St. 1939 - SE corner Marion & Worthington
    - 3. St. Brandon St. 1939 (2020) NW Corner St. Brendan and Marion.
    - 4. Marion St. 1947 - SW corner Marion & David
    - 5. Kingsmount Blvd 1945 - SW corner Kingsmount and Laura
    - 6. Front St. 1945 - SE corner Front and O'Connor
    - 7. Wembley Drive 1945 - NS Wembley Drive (Private Driveway)
  - vii. As a member of the Heritage Advisory Panel, this was discussed in 2017.
  - viii. Ways to preserve these are welcome.
